MEDICAL PROCEDURES

Medical Conditions

It is essential that full details of your child's medical history and medical needs or allergies are recorded on the enrolment form.

We also need to be made aware of any dietary needs ahead of your child arriving.

Please also ensure that we are kept informed of any changes to your child's medical status once your forms have been sent.

Medication

- If your child will require medication during their stay for an existing condition, please ensure the medication is brought with them in its original box and containing full instructions on how to dispense. (Please can instructions on how to take the medicine be written in English)
- The medication will then be checked by our Health Centre nurse who will decide if your child can take the medication themselves, or if they need the nurse to give it to them.
- If the medicine is a controlled drug, this will be stored in a locked safe and given to your child under supervision.
- Any emergency medication, such as inhalers or adrenaline pens must be carried by your child at all times.
- We would prefer your child not to bring any medication which has not been prescribed as our School Nurse can supply appropriate medication for minor illness when required.

What happens if your child becomes ill?

The Summer School nurse or our First Aid trained staff provide immediate first aid and medical assistance to your child.

If your child's condition is more serious, we will either take your child immediately to our local National Health Service doctor or hospital, or telephone for an ambulance.

You will be informed as quickly as possible if the condition is serious.

Important – Your consent to treatment

Under the parent's permission section of the enrolment form, you are signing to give your agreement to all emergency/medical or dental treatments which are necessary for the health of your child, (this may include a general or local anaesthetic or blood transfusion).

We will of course make every effort to contact you if emergency treatment is necessary for your child, however, in the event that we are unable to contact you, we will act in loco parentis on your behalf (as per your signing of the enrolment form) and we will sign the medical consent form agreeing to the treatment on your behalf.

Medical Records

Any treatment your child receives in our Medical Centre will be recorded by our nurse and can be sent to you upon request.
