### STUDENT WELFARE

#### Accommodation

Bedrooms are either single or twin rooms with either en-suite facilities, or shared modern facilities close by. Students are placed near students of a similar age, but different language.

Each boarding area has a House Parent who is responsible for student's pastoral care and will liaise with teachers to check on progress and general wellbeing of the child.

Each area of the boarding house will also have overnight duty staff who sleep in the boarding houses.

#### Pastoral Care & Staff

Our Director of Pastoral Care is responsible for ensuring your child is happy whilst at Stonyhurst and they should be encouraged to speak with the Director if they have any worries about anything whilst here.

All our teachers have a recognised English teaching qualification and are especially chosen for their ability to make summer school both educational and fun.

As required by law, **all** our staff will pass a child protection (Disclosure Barring Service) check.

#### Food

Meals are taken in our separate refectory building, which was built in 2013 and provided by our excellent in-house catering team. Staff and students eat together for all their meals. Attendance at meal times is compulsory and we actively encourage healthy eating.

Children are given the option of hot and cold meals, with a salad bar and fresh fruit available. We always offer a vegetarian option and special dietary requests can be catered for.

We hold regular theme meals e.g. Italian evening

In addition to the 3 main meals, snacks and drinks are provided mid-morning, mid-afternoon and before bed time. Drinks are also provided in the student common room.

#### Healthcare and Medical Insurance

Stonyhurst use their own onsite Health Centre to offer a daily surgery to students. In addition to this we have qualified first aiders on site covering the building 24 hours a day.

If your child is feeling unwell, they should report this to a member of staff as soon as possible.

Whilst accident and emergency is free in the UK, all other treatments must be paid for. This is why we have included in your course fee a student travel insurance. Please see our Studentguard+ Insurance Policy for full details.

#### Laundry

All bedding and one towel is provided per student.

Clothes are washed twice per week and bedding is washed weekly.

Please ensure all clothing is machine washable, can be tumble dried and are all labelled with your child's name.

#### Transport

Students travel by College transport or local coach/taxi companies. All drivers are fully qualified and DBS checked. Students are always supervised and escorted and never travel alone, or on public transport. Students are required to wear seat belts at all times when travelling and are required to be co-operative and well behaved.
